



IsoG 2013 Environmental geochemistry methods, trends, questions

13 - 15 March, 2013 Warsaw, Poland

Idea

State of the environment directly affects the quality of human life. Knowledge about the influence of various factors on the environment, allows a better understanding of the relationship between human activities and the state of the environment. **Isotope methods** are important and frequently used tools for environment studies.

The conference will focus on bridging the newest methodology in isotopic studies and environmental application. The special attention will be put on young researchers starting their scientific career.

The conference will be organized in **three thematic blocks**: methods, applications and "difficult start – tips for young scientists". In every block, a set of high-elevated speaks given by invited key lecturer will be an introduction to poster sessions and panel discussion.

All interested in isotopic methods in study of environment are welcome to participate in the conference and are warmly invited to attend!

The conference will be **fee-free**, but the number of participants is strictly restricted. The classification of delegates will base on the level of submitted abstracts. We also plan to fund a small number of **full-funded conference grants** covering travel costs and hotels, but priority will be given to young scientists starting their career.

The official language of the conference is English. The participants will be expected to present and published their researches in English. The accepted abstracts will be collected in the book of abstracts and distributed to meeting attendees.
